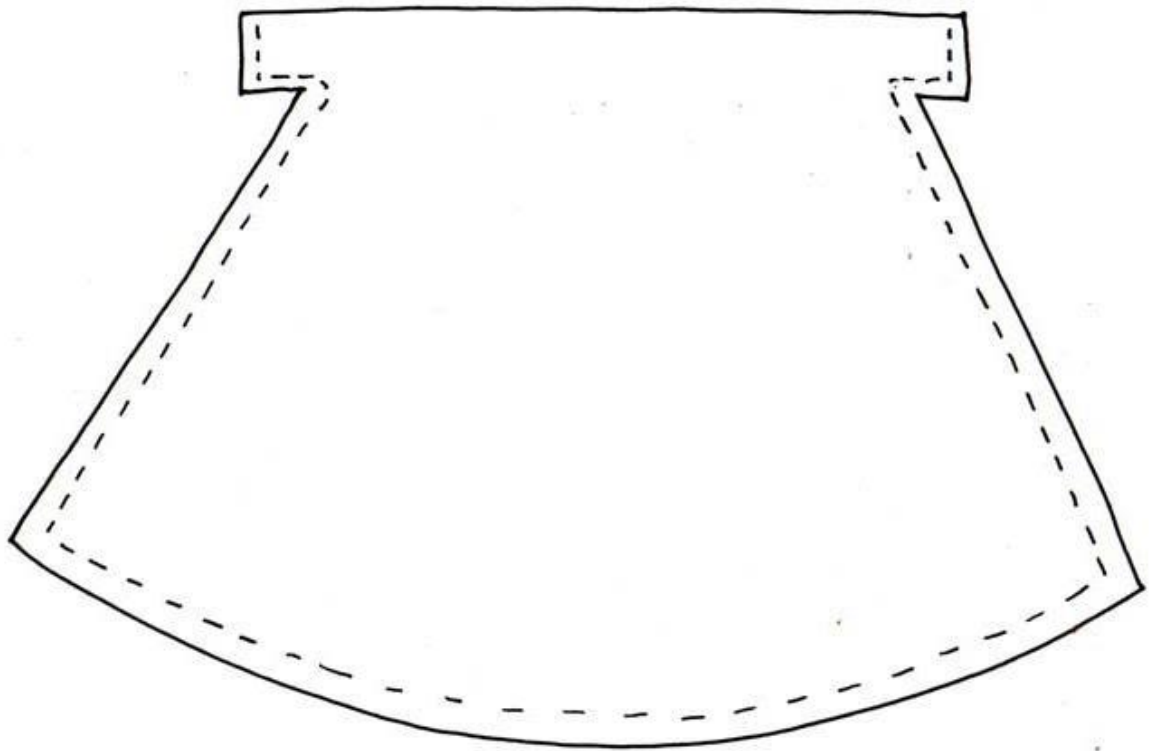

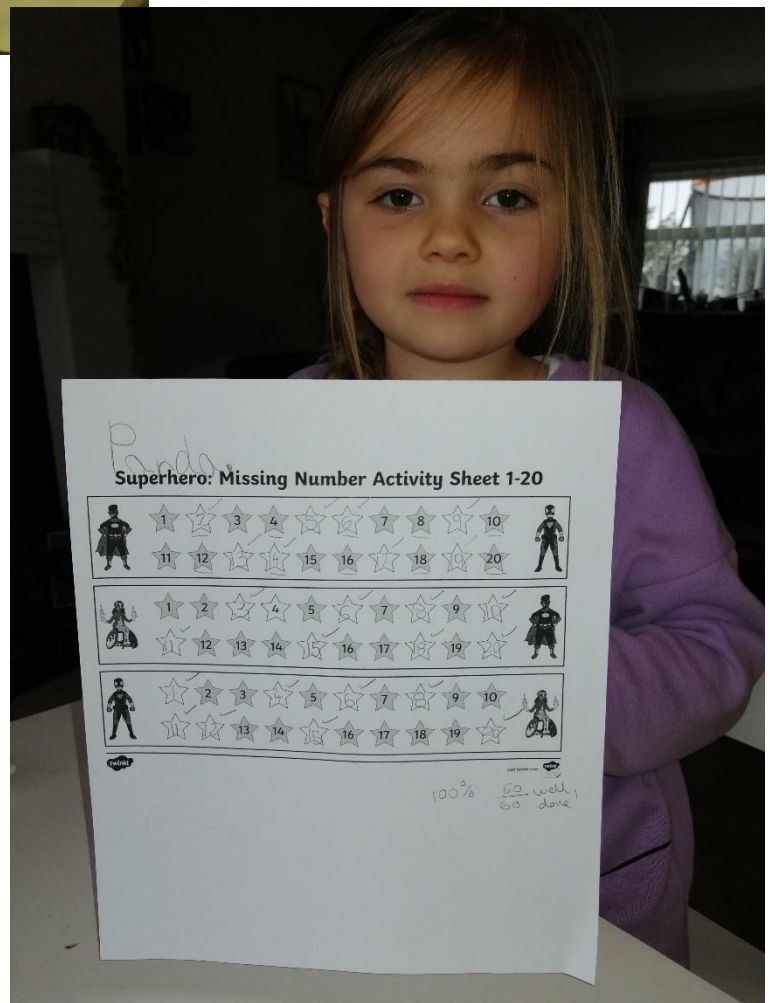


Pandora's family sent me these lovely pictures and a very kind letter. It will indeed be lovely to have all the children back- we have missed you all!

Excellent Superhero maths!



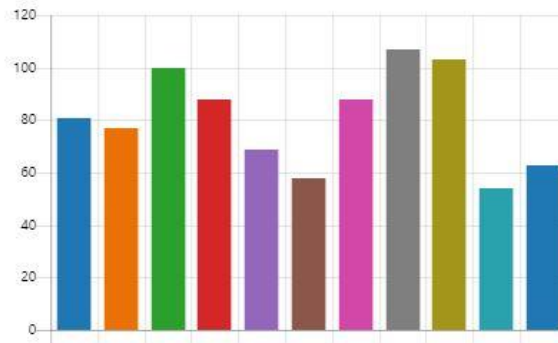
I have spent today writing reports for the Governors about everything we have been getting up to in school and at home. There was a lot to tell them, we have been very busy!

We are definitely going to be doing lots of art workshops, and puppet making seems very popular!

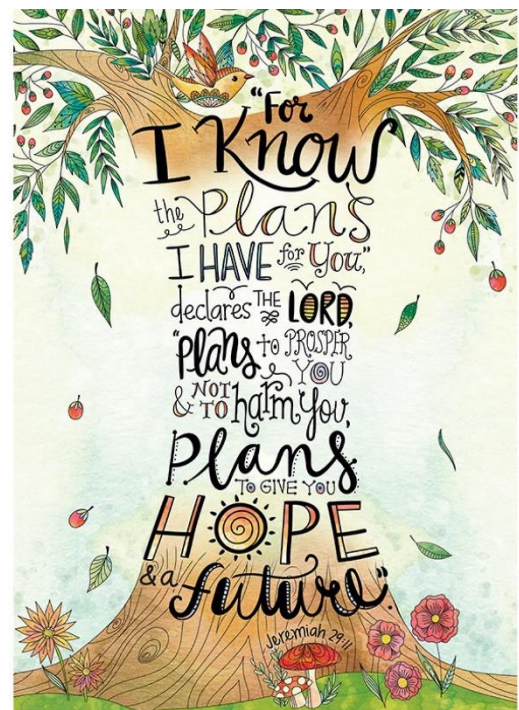
More news will have to wait until tomorrow, I have hungry children at home!
