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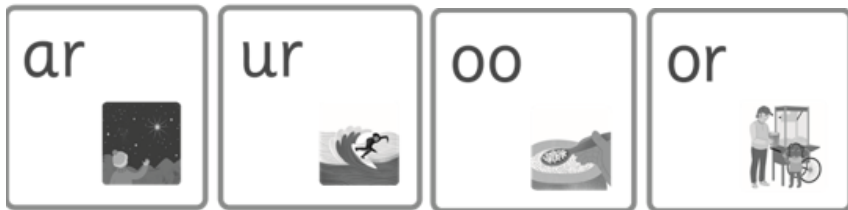
This Week

The children listened to the story of The Three Little Pigs. After discussing the events of the story, we focussed on the Little Pigs' houses. We showed the children a variety of different sorts of homes, including flats, cottages, bungalows and terraced as well as some more unusual places, including barges and campervans. The children were challenged to use their imagination to design and create their own fantasy houses. We then looked at maps of our local area and identified key locations, including school and the church. The children attempted to draw their own maps of a route they like to take to somewhere familiar to them.

Our R.E Topic this Term is 'Stories Jesus Heard'. So far, we have read stories from The Old Testament, including Moses and Noah and The Ark. Can you find these stories in a Bible at home to read together and discuss?

Focus: Composition

The children have been consolidating their understanding of the composition of 5. We have explored part-part-whole relations e.g seeing that 5 can be made of 3 and 2.

We sang The 5 Little Speckled Frog Song, using our fingers to demonstrate the different numbers that add up to 5.
