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This Week

We read the story of Goldilocks and The Three Bears and retold the story using Makaton signs. In Drawing Club, we drew a bear and a map for the bears to find Goldilocks' house. We also wrote captions using our phonics to spell words. We discussed what makes a healthy breakfast and the children tasted some porridge with honey.

We also read Each Peach Pear Plum by Allan and Janet Ahlberg, which features many well-known Fairy Tale and Nursery Rhyme characters. We used this text to discuss the differences between long ago and now, including toys, household objects and homes.
