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<u>This Week</u>

Our focus text was Tad by Benji Davies. Tad is the smallest tadpole in a big pond, where she lives with all her tadbrothers and tadsisters. She is always left behind because she isn't growing and changing as fast as the others. This led us to discuss life cycles and how both humans and animals grow and change. We also looked at where different animals live and what they need to survive e.g. food, water, air and shelter.

In our R.E lesson, we reimagined The Last Supper and reflected on how Jesus' disciples felt when they were told he was going to be leaving them soon.

In our 'myHappymind' lesson we have started the 'appreciate' module where we are learning what being thankful is, how to be grateful for other people and how being grateful makes you feel.
