This Week

This week, we had a science focus to our lessons in Reception. The children learnt what being a scientist means and how we can all be scientists by being curious and asking questions about the world around us. They observed and investigated a number of science experiments. These included exploring why some things float and some things sink, forces using ramps and cars and looking at what happens when you put skittles in warm water (try it at home and see!)

Our R.E topic this term is 'Special Places'. The children have discussed their own special places, including holy places. We read the story of Abraham where God told Abraham to move to a new land and make a new home there. We shared our experiences of moving house and what we did to make the new house feel special.

This week we continued to read and write words of 4 letters and more as well as those ending in ed. For example brushed, looked and camped.'

Focus: Subitising on a rekenrek

A rekenrek is a counting frame, similar to an abacus. It has ten beads on each row, five white and five red which supports the development of number sense.
