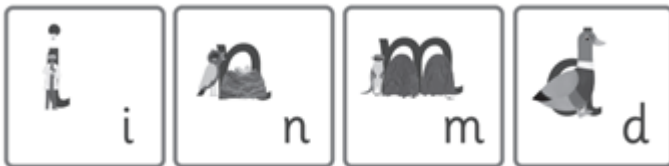
This Week
