This week, the children participated in the first of their daily lessons. They have been playing listening games in small groups to complete a task and to get to know each other. For maths lessons, the children have been counting and practised writing number 1. They have also copied and completed simple colour and shape patterns.

We have also begun to learn about our 5 senses, focusing first on sight. The children have enjoyed exploring the world in different ways using magnifying glasses,

binoculars and microscopes as well as using blindfolds to imagine what it might feel like to lose your sight. We read The Creation Story from The Bible and

discussed the beautiful things we like looking at in God's world. Ideas have included rainbows, whales and 'Mummies'.

The teachers have been really pleased to see so many of the children making friends and adapting so well to school life. They have been learning to follow the classroom rules which include 'Kind hands, Careful feet and Nice words' as well as the carpet time rules:

- 5. Brains switched on
