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Hello everyone,



This week, the children have continued to focus on the story of The Three Little Pigs. They recapped the beginning, middle and end of the story and talked about the characters we met. We looked at real pigs and wolves and learnt how to draw them. We discussed the different materials used by the pigs to build their houses and had a go at using a variety of materials to construct a house of our own.

In phonics lessons, we learnt the 2 letter sounds 'ng', 'ee' and 'or'. We read words containing these sounds and put them in a sentence to write. We also learnt the tricky words 'we', 'me' and 'be'.

In maths, we explored doubles and half of numbers and subtracted from 8 as well as exploring number bonds. We played dice games and dominoes and spotted the 'doubles'.

Our R.E Topic this Term is 'Stories Jesus Heard'. So far, we have read stories from The Old Testament, including Moses and Noah and The Ark. Can you find these stories in a Bible at home to read together and discuss?

We have started our Show and Tell sessions again each Friday so please check when it is your turn to show something to do with our Topic, Once Upon A Time.
