This week, we have been learning about farm animals. We have practised reading and writing the animal names and read lots of stories set on a farm, including 'What the ladybird heard'.

We talked about what happens on a farm and learnt about farms from around the world.

In maths, we focused on number 12 and used a variety of coins to play shopping games with small world farm animals. The children were asked to buy 2 items and add the prices together and some children had a go at giving change.

In our Religious Education lesson, the children started the journey towards understanding what prayer is and the different ways people of faith talk to God. We wrote our own prayers on leaf shapes to make a Prayer Tree. We also attended our first Hymn Practise over at The Infant Building alongside the Year 1 and 2 Classes.
