This week, The Reception Children were lucky enough to go to the Infant Hall to see The Mimika Theatre Company's Production of their wonderful Puppet Play.

We were all mesmerised by their amazing puppets and fantastic storytelling. It was an experience the children will not forget and it inspired lots of creative play when we returned to class. Our theme this week has been looking at boats and ships and talking about journeys they might like to go on in a boat, for example to Australia, to see The Great Barrier Reef. The children used recycled materials to design and make their own vessels and tested them on some water. We talked about floating and sinking and what materials and shapes would be the best to use. Maths lessons have focused on number 18 and we explored how we can use our knowledge of double numbers to add near doubles together, e.g. if we know double 4 is 8, $4+5$ must be one more than 8.
