Spring Term 2 Week 1

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This Week

The children started the week by sharing their Half Term holiday news and using their phonic knowledge to record their favourite moments. As our topic this half term is 'Superheroes', the children have listened to Superhero stories and talked about their favourite famous Superheroes. Each child has created their own superhero identity and they have chosen which super powers they would have.

Phonics

This is a Review week for Phonics so we have revised all the previously learnt sounds and used them to read and write sentences. Please practise the letter sounds and harder to read and spell words we have sent home.

Maths

Focus: Counting, ordinality and cardinality

A key focus has been to consolidate the order of the first 10 numbers.
