Phonics

This week's sounds are:



ow - prowl and growl

oi - coin in the soil

ear - clear that smear

air - a pair in the lair

Maths

Focus: Composition

Sing 5 Little Speckled Frogs

Use fingers on both hands to show numbers that add up to 5, e.g. 4 and 1, 3 and 2, 5 and 0.

Explore how to record the number stories from The Speckled Frog Song.
($5-1 = 4$, $4-1 = 3$)

Weigh out ingredients using scales when baking with your child and discuss quantities.

Home Challenge

We would like the children to ask a member of their family to tell them their favourite Fairy Tale. (It would be great if this could be someone from the older generation, such as a grandparent.) Draw a picture from the story on the record sheet sent home in Reading Bags. These will be shown and discussed in class.
