This Week

This week has been Science week. The Reception children have investigated magnetism, colour liquids mixing, changing solids to as well as force and motion. We have also been learning about how we can be Eco-Heroes. We have challenged the children to come up with ways that they can help save the planet at home, for example, turning off lights, saving water, litter-picking and recycling as much rubbish as possible. We were also visited by Ava's Auntie and her colleague, who are police officers. They talked about their job, keeping everyone safe and how they help people. The children were invited to sit in the cage in the back of the Police Van!

Phonics

This week has been assessment week in Phonics. We have checked how each child is progressing with recognising the Grapheme/Phoneme correspondence as well as the harder to read and spell words. We will let you know any sounds or words your child needs to revise. Please ask if you need any help or advice about this. <u>Maths</u>

Focus: composition

This week the children have used practical contexts to sort objects according to different criteria. They have been encouraged to notice different attributes in groups of objects – such as colour, size of function – and to describe what they notice.

Give your child items to sort in every day contexts, e.g. sorting socks, coins, food.
