Phonics

This week was an Assessment and Review week, which allowed us to revise all the sounds introduced so far and to check each child's progress. Please continue to read regularly at home to ensure your child is applying their sound knowledge at home as well as at school.

<u>Maths</u>

Focus: Composition

Our magic number was 10 so explore the composition of 10 in practical ways, e.g. count out 10 objects and find different numbers that add up to 10 by dividing the group in to sub groups. Have a go at recording this as a sum.

Sing '10 in the bed'

Use language 'more' or 'fewer' when comparing 2 sets of objects.

Build towers together and count how many bricks in each. Which has 'more' bricks and which has 'fewer'?
