Were these miracles or is there some other explanation?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know some of the miracles Jesus performed from different Bible Stories • Discuss and share opinions about Jesus' miracles and offer other explanations <p><u>Week 5, Has Christmas lost its true meaning?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk about why Christmas is meaningful to them • Recap why Christmas is important to Christians • Know what the true meaning of Christmas is for Christians <p><u>Week 6, Are all religious texts true?</u></p>	<p>Talk about what they would enjoy about Diwali if they were Hindu Empathise with what Hindus believe about Diwali Say why Diwali might bring a sense of belonging to Hindus Give my views on whether I would feel a sense of belonging if I celebrated Diwali</p> <p>Ask questions about things they find puzzling about Brahman Share what they think about some Hindu beliefs, including Brahman respectfully Being to explain why religion is important to other people</p> <p>Consider how it might feel for a Hindu to visit the River Ganges and when they take part in the rituals Understand the religious significance of visiting the River Ganges for a Hindu</p> <p>Talk about what puzzles and interests them regarding Jesus' miracles Share their opinion respectfully about whether they believe Jesus healed people Listen and give their opinion of the different interpretations of Jesus' miracles and say if they make sense and why</p> <p>Share what they enjoy most about Christmas Compare the ways Christians and non-Christians celebrate Christmas Explain their beliefs about the true meaning of Christmas and compare their own beliefs to different Christian beliefs</p>
