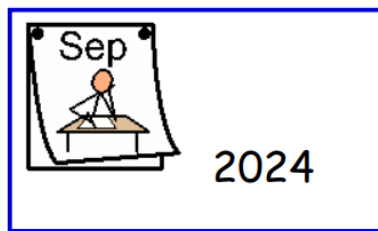

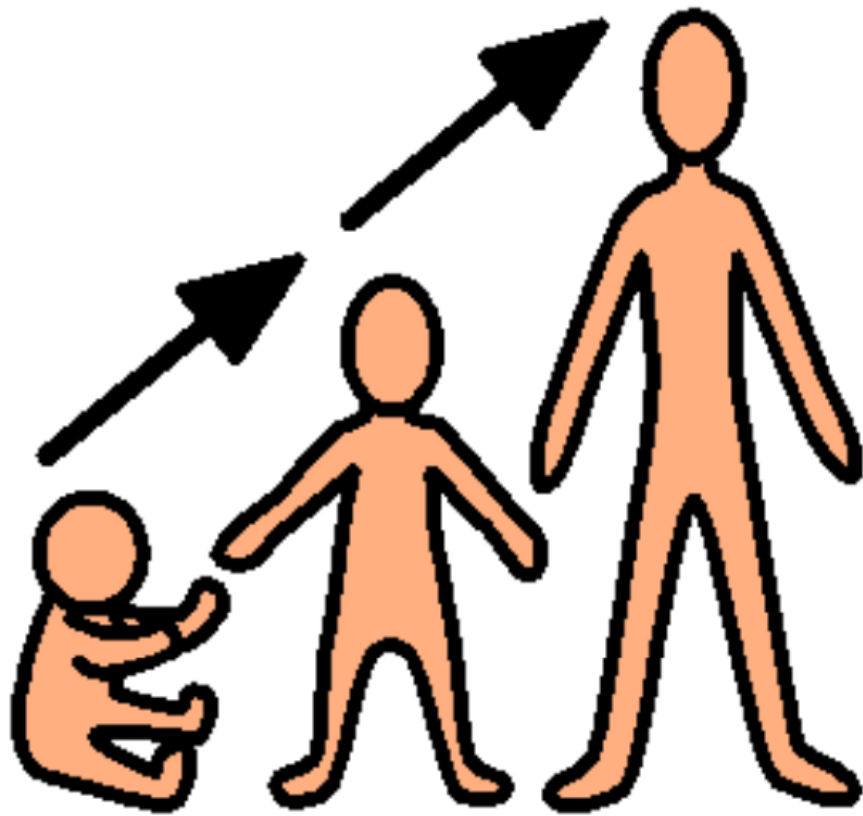

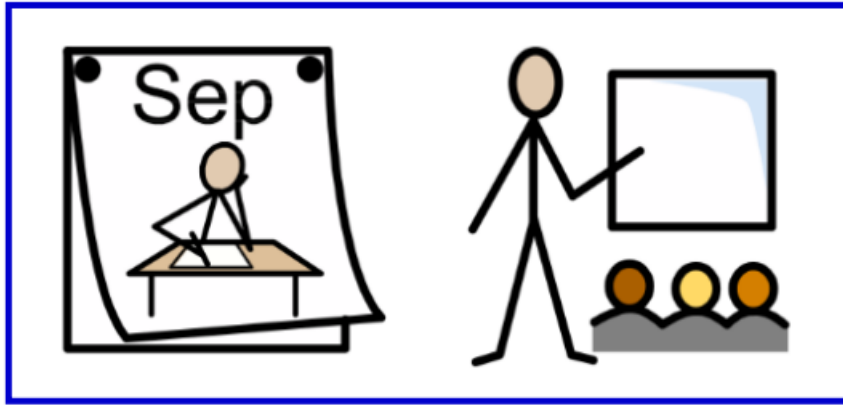


I go to High Green Primary School.



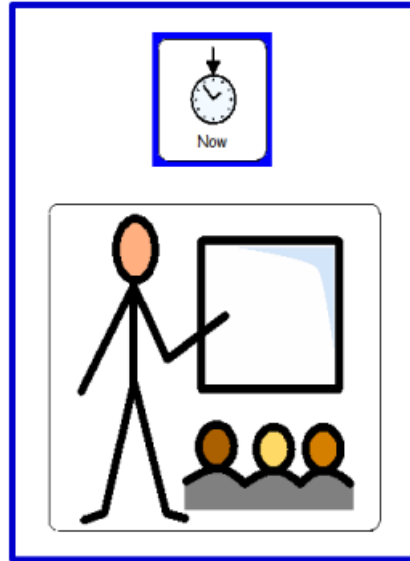


I am growing bigger and getting older.



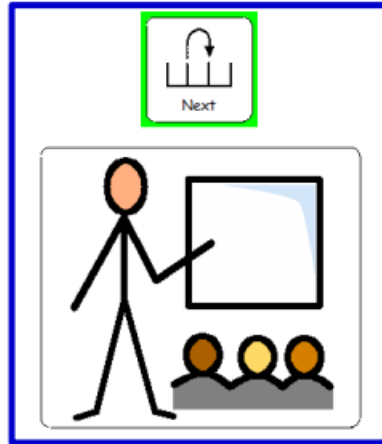
In September I will move

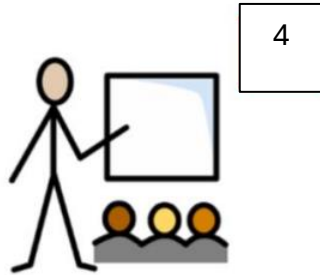




After the long Summer holidays. I will be in Year 4.

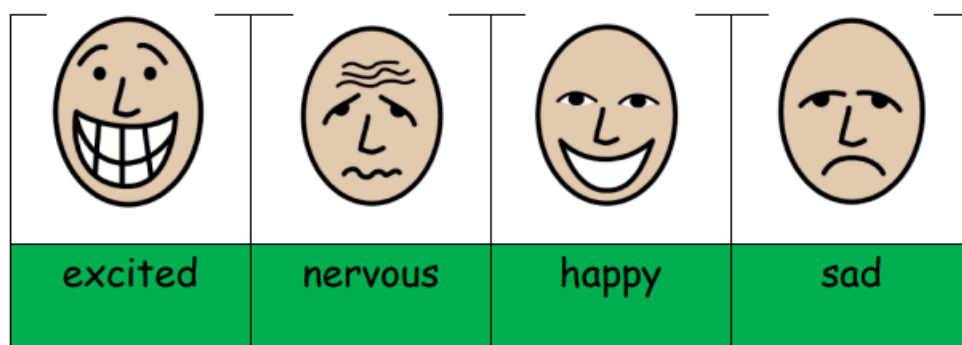
This is what the tables look like.

in Year 3.



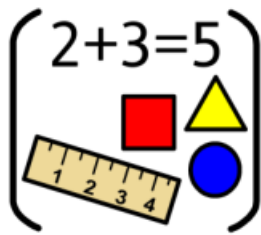

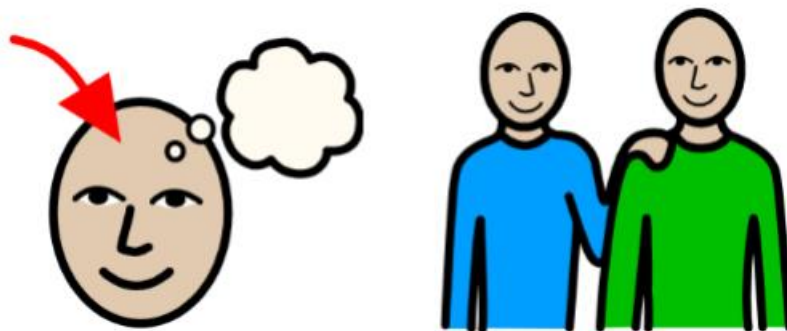
