

## **School Policy for Pupil Premium**

**2017**

### **What is Pupil Premium?**

School's receive additional funding for children who are disadvantaged. This funding should be used to:

- Support children and young people who have parents in the armed forces.
- Raise the attainment and achievement of disadvantaged children so that the gap between them and their peers is narrowed.

### **Principles at High Green**

- We ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all of the pupils.
- We ensure that appropriate provision is made for pupils who belong to vulnerable groups, this includes ensuring that the needs of socially disadvantaged pupils are effectively assessed and addressed.
- In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils, recognise that not all pupils who receive free school meals will be socially disadvantaged.
- We also recognise that not all children who are socially disadvantaged are registered or qualify for free school meals. We reserve the right to allocate the Pupil Premium funding to support any child or groups of children the school has legitimately identified as being socially disadvantaged. Identified groups will include some children identified as Free School Meals.
