Explorers

Adventurers

Adventurers have been learning all about the water cycle and what happens during the different processes of evaporation, condensation and precipitation. We did an investigation with water, put it up in the window to be able to record the process happening in our classroom!

Navigators

We completed a full investigation into how salt when mixed with water, can be reversed to leave salt crystals and looked into how sometimes when materials are burned this cannot be changed back into it's original state.

Weekly Reminders

Medication: Please can we remind parents that medication can only be given during school hours if this is prescribed by a doctor, dentist or nurse. Items should be handed in at the office and permission forms completed. We cannot accept paracetamol, ibuprofen etc. unless these accompany prescribed medication. As always, there are exceptions and in these circumstances please discuss this with Mrs Rourke.

Mobile phones: Mobile phones should only be brought to school by children who walk to and from school unaccompanied or where they are going to a different parent's house. All phones must be handed in at the office for locking away during the day.

Absences: All absences must be notified to school on the day. ParentMail or email (<u>bursar@walton.lancs.sch.uk</u>) is the quickest and easiest way to report an absence and provides a written record. We must ask that full reasons for the absence is given, particularly where this is illness related. Just stating 'not well', 'ill' or unwell' does not allow us to monitor illness absences and in particular infection control.
