Class News

Explorers: Explorers have been thinking about special times in our lives for our new RE unit. We enjoyed painting fire pictures in Art. In PSHE, we have been developing perseverance to complete fun challenges.

Discoverers: We have looked forward to starting all our new topics in Discoverers class. We have been curious to find out more about our new text *'Lizzy and the cloud'*. In maths we have focussed on telling the time and have loved learning about the times of our class routines.
