Learning in school

Explorers

This week the children in Explorers have been introduced to a new text in literacy called "I am Henry Finch". We found the main character (a bird called Henry Finch) sat by himself on a branch in the classroom looking for the rest of his flock. In maths, Explorers have been introduced to the number five. We sang many rhymes with the number 5 in such as "Five Little Speckled Frogs" "Five Little Ducks" and "5 Little Peas".


Let's talk! Ask your child about who was the first man on the moon?

Discovers

In Discoverers this week we have been reading the BFG by Roald Dahl and have really enjoyed creating exciting sentences using adjectives. In maths, we have been using strategies to add and subtract 1s and 10s. In science, we looked at the Arctic Circle and carried out an investigation to help us understand how people keep warm in colder climates!

Let's talk! Ask your child to tell you how many countries are inside the Arctic Circle?







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Adventurers

In Adventurers class this week we have started to read 'The lion, the witch and the wardrobe' as part of our English and guided reading lessons. The children have been very engaged with the start of the story and are excited to find out more about the main characters.

Let's talk! Ask your child at home about the book so far and talk to them about the situation Mr Tumnus found himself in. Also, why they think the wardrobe didn't work when Lucy told her siblings about Narnia.

Navigators

This week in Navigators, we have started a new English unit based on the Three Little Pigs, with a twist! We have really enjoyed being 'defence attorneys', providing motives for the pigs who admitted to arson. We have also learnt how to do long multiplication and we know what to do when multiplying with a tens number. In history we became historians, researching 'Sutton Hoo' and the importance of this magnificent find.

Let's talk! Ask your child what Sutton Hoo is and why it is important?
