# CLASS STRUCTURE

Our class structure this year is as follows:

### Foundation Stage (Nursery/Reception)

Class size: 25 children Class teacher: Miss Buckley (Monday to Wednesday); Mrs Noblet (Thursday and Friday) Teaching assistant: Mrs Bethell (full time), Mrs Aldwin (part time)

### <u>Year 1</u>

Class size: 21 children Class teacher: Miss Bray Teaching assistants: Miss Roberts (part time)

### <u>Year 2/3</u>

Class size: 27 children Class teacher: Mrs Proctor. Teaching assistants: Miss Whittle (part time)

### <u>Year 4/5</u>

Class size: 33 children Class teacher: Mrs Plowman (Tuesday to Friday) and Mrs Noblet (Mondays) Teaching assistants: Miss Marsden and Mrs Stevenson (part time)

## <u>Year 6</u>

Class size: 15 children Class teacher: Mrs Clayton (4 days) Mrs Noblet (Wednesdays)

## <u>P.E.</u>

On PE days, children should wear their PE kit to school. Jogging bottoms or leggings may be worn instead of shorts, and school sweatshirts/fleeces may be worn for warmth. (School shoes may be worn and trainers brought in a named PE bag to change into; this should be hung on their chair or peg)
