COVID-19

A handy advice sheet for parents produced by Lancashire County Council is being sent out with the newsletter.

Guidance from the 119 service this week advises that if your child has been in contact with someone outside your household who has tested positive they need to isolate from school for 14 days from the date of the last contact with that person. They should then only return to school if they are not showing symptoms. This is the same advice for when NHS Test and Trace identifies your child as a close contact of a confirmed case.

NASAL FLU VACCINATIONS

Vaccinations will take place in school on Friday 6th November. Details of how to book your child's vaccination were sent out by email on 13th October. **Please ensure that you complete the online form by midnight on Thursday 29th October.** You are strongly encouraged to have your child vaccinated, however those children for whom we do not receive consent will not be included in the programme and you will need to make your own arrangements for them to receive the vaccine.
