REMINDERS

CAR PARK/ROAD SAFETY

Once again it is disappointing to receive more complaints of cars driving on the pavement on Rosewood Avenue. This week five cars have been observed, all of whom were visiting school. What is more concerning is that there were pedestrians on the pavement at the time. This is becoming an increasing problem and we would ask that drivers leaving school observe the Highway Code and where there are parked cars that they give way to oncoming traffic.

Speed of traffic in the school car park also remains a concern and again we would ask all parents and carers to drive slowly and carefully in and out of the car park.

Please ensure that the two disabled parking spaces at the front of school are kept clear for designated users and that you do not park in the space adjacent to the disabled parking spaces and along the fence by the path as these are for staff only.
