100% Perfection 0 days off school Equates to 2 days off 99% Excellent school each year Good Slight Concern Equates to 20 days off 90% Concerned school each year Equates to 30 days off 85% Very Concerned school each year

5 days absence over the whole year

Good chance of success and progress 20 days absence over the whole year

90%

Less chance of success. Harder to make progress 20+ days absence over the whole year
