Topic: Vikings

History

In History we will be learning all about the Viking invasion of Britain. We will start off by understanding why and how they invaded. Following this, we will learn about what the Vikings did whilst living here, place events on a timeline using dates and consider different accounts of the invasion.

Geography

In Geography, we will be using maps and atlases to locate Scandinavia, the UK and surrounding area. We will research the differences between the two places.

Art

In Art we will be focusing on sketching techniques and focus on applying them to drawing a Viking longship Dragon head. We will focus on sketching drafts and producing a final piece to showcase in class

Design Technology

In DT, we will be designing and making our own Viking longships with the aim of making it float. We will choose buoyant materials and design, make and evaluate our models.

Aspirations

During our DT lessons, we will be considering Viking longboats and different inspirational designs. We will discuss what made the Vikings such good sailors and navigators.

Community

We will learn about Viking communities including their jobs and groups they belonged to.

Culture

We will learn about Viking culture and share ideas about comparisons it to modern day culture.

Health

We will consider how Vikings stayed safe – using armour and shields for protection.

English

English lessons will focus on different aspect of the curriculum for reading and writing based on the needs of each individual learner.

Guided reading activities will also include focusing on the individual targets and needs of each child in class.

We will use The Vikings as a focus for reading and writing where appropriate and shared story times will follow a Viking theme.

Maths

In maths we will be covering:

- Multiplication and division
- Length and Perimeter
- Decimals
- Number
- Fractions

We will continue to use TT Rockstars to ensure we know our timetables.

Mastery Math Friday lessons will focus on recapping previously learned areas in Math and revisiting skills.

Science

During our forest school sessions, we will be learning about plants. This include types of plants, how to care for plants and naming plants, their parts and their functions.

In Science we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will classify and group living things. We will consider how each living things survives and uses its habitat to live.

Modern Foreign Languages

Wherever possible we will discuss other languages and various greetings during register or classroom discussions.

Music

We will focus on Rock ' N ' Roll in afternoon music lessons and learn about various hits from the past.

Computing

In Computing we will be focusing on improving our typing skills, aiming to use all digits for speed and accuracy.

We will then learn about E-mailing and databases.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about 'Safety and the Changing Body'. We will be thinking about how we can stay safe online and who we should share information with.

We will also be learning about puberty and will be thinking
