Rail travel made it cheaper and easier for people and their families to travel to the seaside.



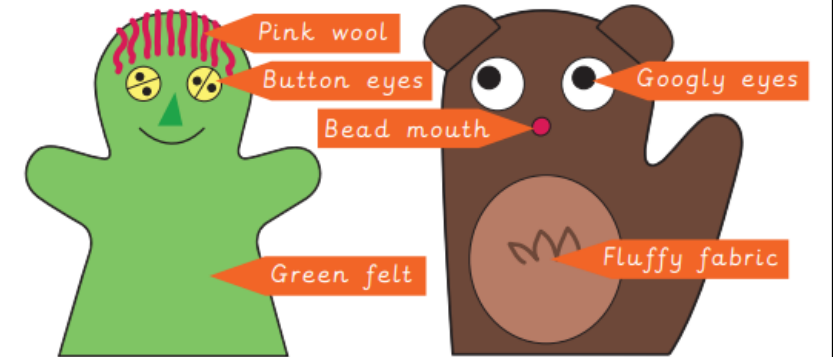

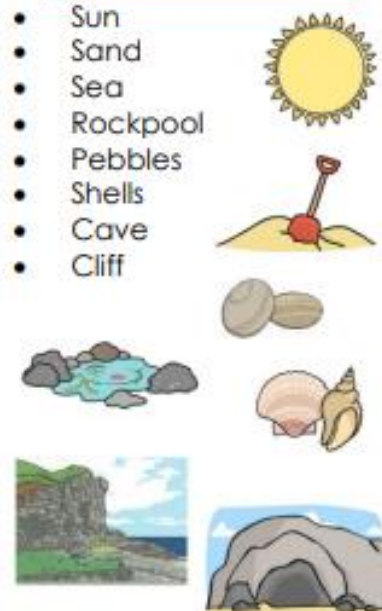
