#### Headteacher's update

Happy New Year! I hope that you had a good Christmas and that yours wasn't too disrupted by Covid. I sent out a letter earlier this week with the new guidance regarding isolation following a positive test result or being a close contact. We currently have relatively low numbers of positive cases within the school community but I do think that this will increase over the next few weeks. We need to try and limit the impact by ensuring we continue to test, isolate when necessary and by wearing face masks.
