Dear Families,

It was lovely to see the children return from their half term break so happy to be back at school. They have been full of great stories about what they had been up to during the holiday.

First of all could I please remind all visitors to the site to ensure that when parking they only park in marked bays. Also please follow the instructions of the transport team so that pick up and drop off time can be as safe and smooth as possible. Parking on footpaths where not instructed can post a significant safety risk to pedestrians in the area.

We are aware that there was difficulty in delivering some immunisations at school recently. We have had information from the team and the Immunisation Team will revisit next **Wednesday 9th November to administer the Covid Booster Vaccination** that had to be abandoned before half term (20/10/22) – no further consent is needed for those students involved. Also any **Y8** students who have already consented will have their **HPV1 on Wednesday 16th November** (letter posted on dojo 09/09/22): You must accept or decline this vaccination by completing the online form. Please click on this link <https://imms.hct.nhs.uk/hpv/2022/cambsandpeterborough/> Immunisation Form and complete the form. You will need this **unique code number EE140882** which identifies your child's school. The electronic link will close at 2:00:00 PM on Tuesday, November 15, 2022. Please note the form will not work on some mobile phones and tablets. For students in **Y9** who have already had the HPV1 will have their booster on the same day but will not be required to consent again. Should you have any difficulties or questions please contact the Immunisation Team on 0300 555 5055.

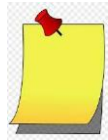
