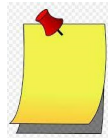

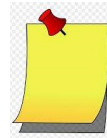

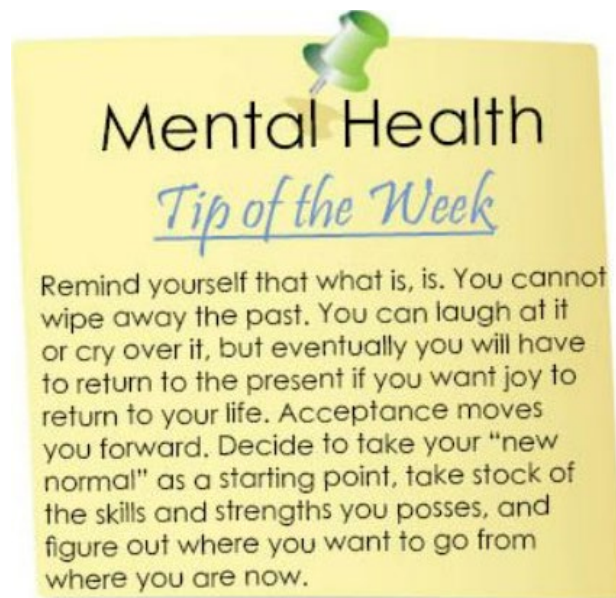


Important Information
