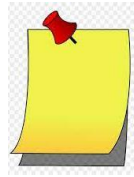

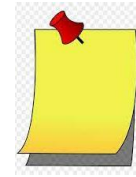

### Online Safety Tip of the Week:

What to do if your account is hacked?

When reporting online abuse, save evidence whenever possible. Evidence can be saved by taking screenshots.

Report your account by contacting the credit card company, bank, or health insurer **ONLY** through their OFFICIAL phone number located on their official website.

If your identity is stolen or you have responded to a scam, immediately change the passwords and PINs on all your accounts, and report the incident to your credit card company, bank, or health insurer.
