Destinations of Year 11 Students

Educated in Cambridgeshire (**not** including Independent Schools)

This booklet gives detailed figures about the destinations of students in Cambridgeshire who had reached statutory school leaving age by 31st August 2023.

Please note that these tables relate to the activities and status of young people at 1st November 2023, rather than to their first destination after leaving statutory education. This is the date we are asked to use by the Department for Education and is considered to be a more reliable indicator of sustained participation. Percentages may not always add up to 100, due to rounding of figures.

Some of the tables in this pack are a result of very detailed analysis. If you are unsure of the derivation of any information, or its meaning, please contact Mark Cowdell.

Summary: Year 11 destinations – 2023 and 2022 compared (please see table 2 for previous years comparison)

The figures for ALL students show:

- the overall numbers in the year 11 cohort is larger than last year (**6709** compared to 6213)
- there has been a decrease in the percentage of young people moving into full time education, now **90.91%** (91.58% in 2022)
- a slight decrease in the percentage of young people in learning, now **95.23%** (95.51% in 2022)
- an increase in the percentage of young people who are NEET (not in education, employment or training) now **2.85%** (2.29% in 2022)
- a slight decrease in the percentage of young people going into employment with training, now **3.22%** (3.40% in 2022)
- a slight increase in the percentage of young people going into employment without any accredited training, now **1.64%** (1.61% in 2022)

The figures for students from Mainstream Schools only show:

- the percentage of students moving into full time education has decreased to **92.39%** (93.82% in 2022)
- a slight decrease in percentage of young people going into employment with training, now **3.13%** (3.31% in 2022)
- an increase in percentage of young people going into employment without any accredited training, now **1.26%** (0.87% in 2022)
- the percentage of young people NEET has significantly increased, now **2.17%** (1.19% in 2022)

We have again split down reports for students in special schools, those attending alternative provision, those electively home educated and also a table for all students eligible for pupil premium.

The figures for students from Special Schools, show:

- % of students moving into full time education has slightly decreased from last year to **87.04%** (87.88% in 2022)
- % of young people in learning has decreased to **93.21%** (93.94% in 2022)
- % of young people who are in employment without training has increased to **2.47%** (0.00% in 2022)
- % of young people who are NEET has positively decreased to **4.32%** (6.06% in 2022)

The figures for students from Elective Home Education, show:

- % of students moving into full time education has decreased to **66.67%** (68.56% in 2022)
- % of young people in learning has significantly increased to **79.32%** (73.2% in 2022)
- % of young people who are in employment without training has decreased to **9.28%** (15.98% in 2022)
- % of young people who are NEET has increased to **10.97%** (7.73% in 2022)

Summary (cont.): Year 11 destinations – 2023 and 2022 compared

The figures for students from Alternative Education Provision, show:

- % of students moving into full time education has slightly increased to **60.99%** (59.41% in 2022)
- % of young people in learning has also slightly increased to **69.15%** (68.62% in 2022)
- % of young people who are in employment without training has decreased to **7.45%** (8.37% in 2022)
- % of young people who are NEET has increased to **23.40%** (21.76% in 2022)

The figures for students eligible for Pupil Premium, show:

- % of students moving into full time education has decreased to **85.48%** (87.14% in 2022)
- % of young people in learning has decreased to **90.41%** (91.24% in 2022)
- % of young people who are in employment without training has slightly increased to **2.47%** (2.38% in 2022)
- % of young people who are NEET has significantly increased to **6.83%** (5.73% in 2022)

This year we have also provided a table for all young people with EHCP's and those who are noted as being SEN Support (the data for SEN support has a health warning as whether the information has been recorded on our system)

For those with EHCP

- % of students moving into full time education is recorded as to **84.91%**
- % of young people in learning is recorded as **91.91%**
- % of young people who are in employment without training in recorded as **1.08%**
- % of young people who are NEET has been recorded as **7.01%**

For those with SEN Support

- % of students moving into full time education is recorded as to **83.43%**
- % of young people in learning is recorded as **89.92%**
- % of young people who are in employment without training in recorded as **2.90%**
- % of young people who are NEET has been recorded as **6.91%**






Destination of Mainstream School pupils

Destination of Elected Home Education pupils







Destination of SEN Support pupils





Destination of all Male pupils


