

### Counter Terrorism and Security Act 2015

Schools must have:

‘due regard to the need to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism’.

### Aim of Prevent:

To prevent people becoming terrorists or supporting terrorism.

### How?

By supporting and protecting those people who are vulnerable to radicalisation.

### **CHANNEL:**

An early intervention multi-agency approach to safeguard individuals at risk of radicalisation. At the Channel Panel, an action plan will be drawn up providing support for the individual.

# PREVENT

### Radicalisation

Defined as the process by which an individual comes to support terrorism and extremist ideologies linked to terrorist groups.

### NEXT:

Checks are completed and Chair of Channel Panel determines suitability for Channel Programme.

### Extremism

Defined as the vocal or active opposition to fundamental British values.

OFSTED will inspect schools' compliance with this duty.

### NOTICE - CHECK - SHARE

Follow safeguarding procedures and report any concerns to DSL. DSL will complete VTR (Vulnerable to Radicalisation) referral form.

### Behaviours of Concern

Contact with extremist recruiters, loss of interest in friends/activities not associated with extremist ideology, possessing/accessing materials associated with extremist ideologies, using extremist language, graffiti symbols associated with extremist ideologies, significant changes to behaviour/appearance, attempts to recruit others, use of derogatory names for other groups, involvement in PRI.

### British Values

Democracy, rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect and tolerance of different faiths and beliefs.
