



Year 2 overview: Spring Term



In English this term we will be exploring funny poems. Can you make a list of rhyming words for:

We will be learning about money in Maths this term. Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s as this really helps with money. Can you count a pile of coins?



We will be exploring materials in Science this term. Can you find these materials in your home? Can you talk about the properties of these materials? Are the materials flexible? Rigid? Hard? Soft? Brittle?



In Geography, we will be learning about Nairobi. Can you find it on a map? Can you think of some interesting words to describe Nairobi? Is it urban, rural or coastal? What would it be like to grow up in Nairobi?



In History, we are learning about the history of Ipswich. We have been finding out about Thomas Wolsey, who was born in the town. The Ipswich Waterfront also helps us understand the town's past. You could go for a walk along the Waterfront and see if you can spot any buildings that were once factories.



We will be learning about the beliefs of Muslims in RE this term. We start by thinking about special and important people in our lives. Who is special and important to you? Is there a way you can show them they are important to you?



In Art, we will be doing printmaking. The children will create their own blocks and use them to make repeated patterns. Can you use pencils to create your own repeated patterns by drawing different shapes.



In PSHE, we will be learning about how to keep ourselves safe both indoors and outdoors. As part of this, we will focus on ways to stay safe when walking to school. Can you create a poster that shows important safety tips and rules for walking safely, such as crossing the road carefully, being visible to drivers, and staying alert at all times?
