If your child has an illness (sickness or diarrhoea), they must be kept off Nursery for a full **48 hours from the last episode of illness**.

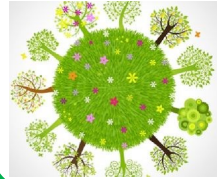
Please phone the office before 8.45am to inform us of your child's absence.

Please send your child in **with** their welly boots (in addition to their normal school shoes).



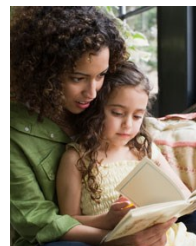
If it is wet or muddy, we will dress them in our blue puddle suits.
