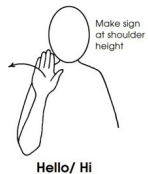

Monday 23rd —Literacy

We will be reading 'Who Are You'. Looking at what we like and dislike.

Tuesday 24th—Maths

This week the children will explore secondary colours. They will be introduced to the vocabulary related to colour mixing. During this lesson we will learn the colour purple.

Wednesday 25th—Maths

In this lesson, children will expand their knowledge of colour mixing and secondary colours and learn the colour green.

Thursday 26th—Maths

Building on the prior knowledge in this lesson the children will learn about the colour orange.

To consolidate our learning on colours and exploring our school environment looking for all the colours learnt. With the start of Autumn we will look at the trees on our grounds to observe the changes which are starting in seasons.
