Toothbrushing

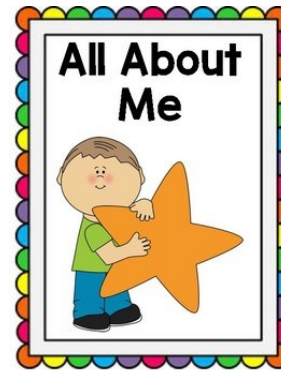
Thank you for all the replies regarding toothbrushing. Next week we will be starting to clean our teeth.
