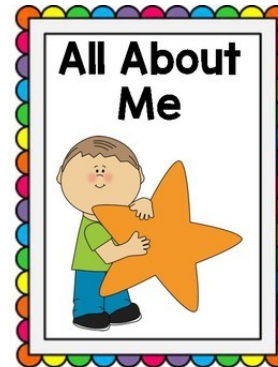

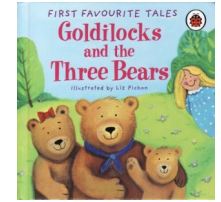

We will be going on an adventure to explore the playground.


One Finger, One Thumb
