

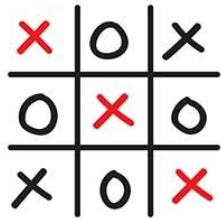

Maths Game

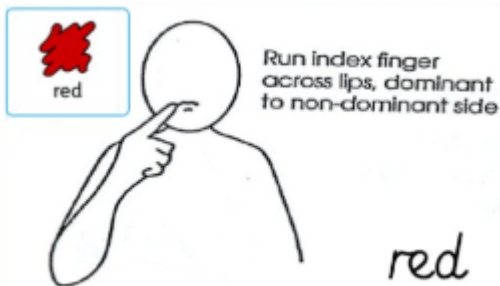
Together you can play the game of noughts and crosses (tic tac toe). It's great for practicing our counting to 3.
