Bookbag and Drawstring bag

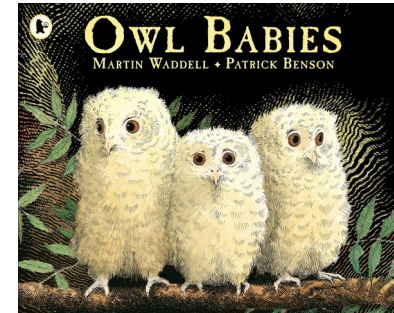
Please could we remind you that each child will **need a bookbag** which comes to and from school each day.
