

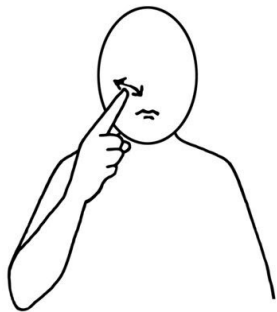
**PE**

Please can we remind you of the school uniform which all children are required to wear each day:

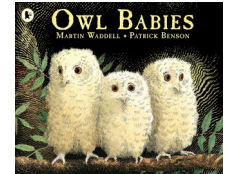

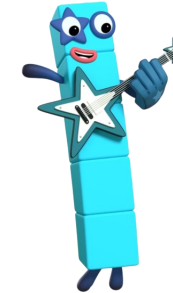
