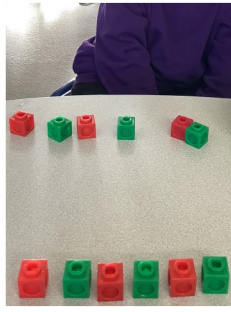
Mr Manning, our caretaker, has been spreading salt on the school paths but please take extra care on your journey to school.

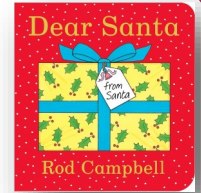
Jewellery
