This week we are moving on to learn about animal habitats. Which animals live where? To support our theme, we will be reading the story Welcome Home Bear by II Sung Na.




Bear decides he wants to love in another habitat but after visiting a few, decides he is just where he needs to be!

In maths we have been looking at numbers 1,2 and 3 using Numberblocks characters. The children enjoy watching these short episodes (found on BBC iPlayer or Amazon Prime) and then practising the concept afterwards with blocks and games. There are also toys and wipe clean books that you can purchase too.



We have been practising 'subitising', that is, recognising how many things are in a group without counting them. We can use dice patterns to help or just a random arrangement of items up to 5. We are starting with up to 3 items.



Please ensure each child has a small drawstring bag of spare clothes that they can keep on their peas in case of accidents. They do not need to bring these home every day. Children should also have a **bookbag** to take home their books and letters each dav.
