

This week we will be tapping for bugs in our nursery garden. We will then look at our bug ID sheets to identify what we have found.




Friday 7th — Maths



Today we will be looking at hidden numbers on the number track—what number comes after 3?

Starting School



Over the next 5 weeks, we will be sharing more details linked to the statements in the picture.

These are the 'ingredients' that help your child to be ready for school.

These statements are worked on throughout your child's entire time in nursery so will be useful information to have for all children.

Summer: Week 8 Number Composition

When you spot numbers in the environment around you, for instance door numbers on the way the to school, ask you children to identify the numeral and then ask them "What comes after that number?" With door numbers you could point out how the next number is on the opposite side of the road.

Play with some dominoes. Look at which number is represented on each domino. See if you child can sequence the dominoes e.g. This domino shows 1 spot. What comes after? Can you find a domino that shows 2 spots? What comes after that?



Sing counting rhymes that recite the numbers in order e.g. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 Once I Caught a Fish Alive or One, Two Buckle My Shoe. Pretend to forget the words and ask your child to help you e.g. you could say, "What comes after 3?"
