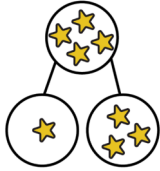




Reception Week Ahead

Maths

Now the children know how the 'part, part whole' model works, we move on to learning about how numbers can be split into parts.



We can represent this on the model or write it as a simple sum.

Eg. $2 + 3 = 5$

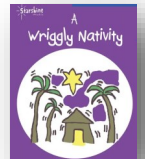
Christmas Jumper Day
