Maths— The children have been learning about sharing equally in the first week of this half term.

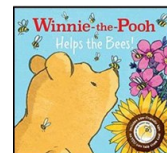
The page on the reverse of this newsletter will help your child to practise this skill. Next week we will be moving on to Volume and Capacity and making a cake to practice!
