Maths

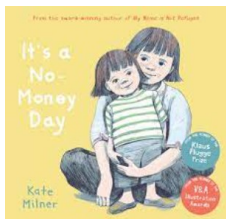
We will be comparing objects and finding different ways that we can sort them.
