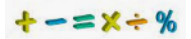


Writing

This term we will be looking at poetry and exploring pattern and rhyme. We will use our knowledge to write poems in different shapes! The children will also be describing settings with detail and exploring stories with familiar settings.



Maths



This term we will be working hard on developing number sense and continuing to develop our understanding of numbers to 10. We will learn how to use a part whole model and how these can help us add and subtract. We will also spend some time looking at 2D and 3D shapes and



History

In our History lessons, we will learn about changes in our lifetimes. We will compare shops in our local area and look at what shops used to be like.

Geography

Pupils will be learning the names of the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world as well as looking at the countries within the United Kingdom.

Art



Pupils will be using a range of art resources to draw, including charcoal, pencil, chalk and pastel. We will consider applying different pressures to make the marks change. We will also be exploring how to make thick and thin paint marks on a range of surfaces.

Science
