Year 1 Overview



This term, we will learn how to write a recount from a personal experience. We will also use our knowledge to write informal letters. The children will be looking at poetry on a theme. The theme will be Nature.

History

In our History lessons, we will learn about the lives of significant individuals who have contributed to national and international achievements. We will explore the lives of David Attenborough, Mary Anning, Neil Armstrong, Mae Jemison, Bernard Harris and Tim Peake. Spring Term Reading

Art

Pupils will explore the marks that can be made by printing with a range of objects. We will be learning the techniques of stencilling and relief printing. We will combine these printing techniques to create a final piece, inspired by the work of the contemporary artist Karen Lederer. Maths +-=×÷%

This term, we will be working hard on developing number sense and continuing to strengthen our understanding of numbers up to 20. We will learn how to use a number line and how these can help us add and subtract. We will also look at 2D and 3D shapes and investigate their properties.

Geography

We will learn about the hot and cold locations. We will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

DT

Pupils will learn about the nutritional value of vegetables and why colourful food can be better for us. We will use a range of culinary techniques to create various dishes.



In RE we will learn about the day when Jesus rode into Jerusalem. We will understand why Jesus was welcomed like a king on Palm Sunday.



We will identify and name various everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal and rock. Children will also describe the simple physical properties of various everyday materials. Can you make a window from metal? Will a raincoat made from paper be useful?
