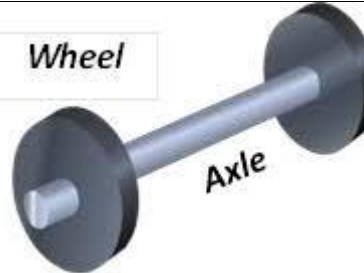

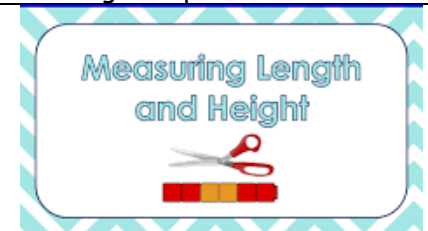
In History, we are learning about the history of Landguard Fort in Felixstowe. Why did people in the past think Felixstowe would need defending?
