History

Science

Science this term will explore materials we use everyday and why we use specific materials. Why can't a window pane be made from metal? What if we made a raincoat from paper? The children will explore these ideas and much more.

Maths

This term in Maths, we will be learning how to add money to create specific amounts. We will be learning multiplication and division using the symbols x and . We will build on the learning the children have already done about length and height and towards the end of the term, we will explore mass, capacity and temperature.

Geography



In Spring term, we will be comparing the geography of Nairobi to the geography of our local area. We shall compare the physical features as well as the climate in these two contrasting places.
